ANNUAL HURRICANE CONTRACT FOR 2012

Annual hurricane contracts are intended to benefit Jarrett Bay's full service customers and will be sold on a first come first served basis. We will accept the first 100—50 and 75 ton lifts and a maximum of 20—200 ton lifts this year. We will not accept additional customers once we reach these numbers. All contracts must be completed, signed and received NLT 01 APRIL 2012 with payment to be valid. We will sell any remaining contracts on a case by case basis after April 01 to anyone requesting a contract and may not sell any contracts after 15 May. **Any vessel hauled as a result of a tropical storm or hurricane that does not have a contract will be billed the amount of the contract they would have required plus other applicable expenses. ** These vessels will only be hauled if time and space allow. You cannot be hauled unless you have purchased a contract and meet the requirements set forth below.

This is an annual agreement that covers the 2012 hurricane season. This contract will guarantee a place on the JBBW yard in the event a hurricane threatens the area provided the **Owner/Captain** of said vessel schedules the haul out within the prescribed time frame and guidelines required to allow ample time prior to Gale Force Winds. The **Owner/Captain** is solely responsible for contacting JBBW when hurricane force winds are projected within 5 days of land fall. JBBW Inc. uses the NOAA projections to commence scheduling and hauling of vessels. Vessels that do not schedule a haul out within the prescribed time frame forfeit their guarantee and will only be scheduled for haul out on a case by case basis if time allows. Vessels to be hauled by the 50 and 75 ton lift will be scheduled at 30 minute intervals and the 200 ton lift at 2 hour intervals. It is imperative that all vessels meet there scheduled times to assure a timely organized effort to ensure all customers are treated fairly and equally. The **Owner/Captain** is responsible for delivery, pickup and securing vessel for heavy weather. Power is very limited and will probably be interrupted in the event of a storm. All spoilable food, bait etc. should be removed from the vessel. Owner is responsible for haul out and storage fees in addition to the cost of this contract and payment will be required at time of vessel departure.

RATES : Vessels up to 62' with a beam of 18' or less and under 75 tons	\$15.00 per ft.
Vessels up to 80' with a beam in excess of 18' 50-200 tons	\$17.50 per ft.
Vessels over 80' with a beam of 18-30' to 200 tons	\$19.00 per ft.
