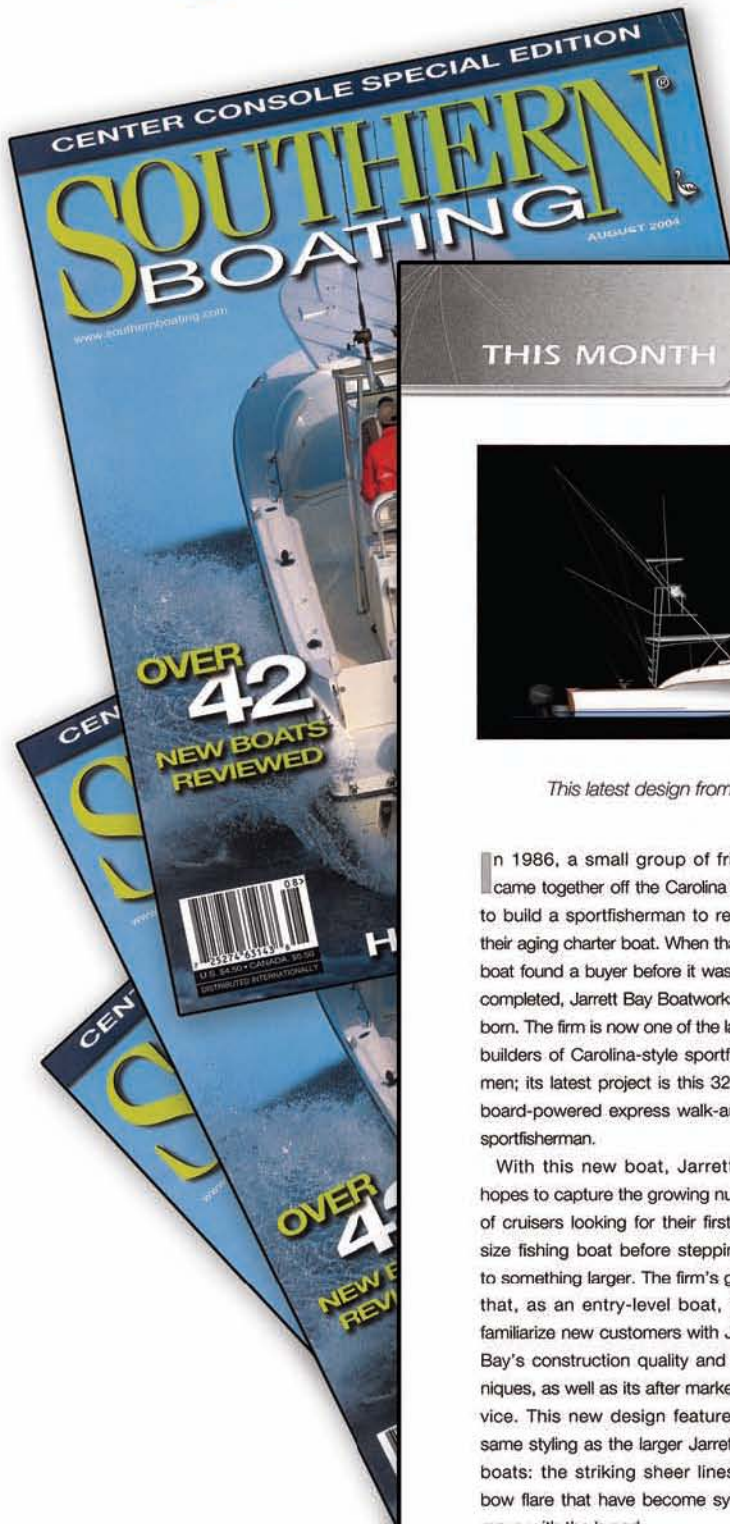

JARRETT BAY BOATWORKS PRESENTS A NEW 32'
EXPRESS WALK-AROUND SPORTFISHERMAN

This latest design from Jarrett Bay is intended to be their version of an "entry-level" sportfisherman.

In 1986, a small group of friends came together off the Carolina coast to build a sportfisherman to replace their aging charter boat. When that first boat found a buyer before it was even completed, Jarrett Bay Boatworks was born. The firm is now one of the largest builders of Carolina-style sportfishermen; its latest project is this 32' outboard-powered express walk-around sportfisherman.

With this new boat, Jarrett Bay hopes to capture the growing number of cruisers looking for their first mid-size fishing boat before stepping up to something larger. The firm's goal is that, as an entry-level boat, it will familiarize new customers with Jarrett Bay's construction quality and techniques, as well as its after market service. This new design features the same styling as the larger Jarrett Bay boats: the striking sheer lines and bow flare that have become synonymous with the brand.

The designers included all the features needed to keep anglers happy, including a transom mounted fish box, built-in baitwells, and plenty of storage

space for rods and other gear. The walk-around console houses a cuddy cabin, for overnight or weekend trips. It will sleep two in V-bunks, with a head and shower, plus additional interior storage space for personal gear.

In a departure from its traditional cold-molded construction, Jarrett Bay will build the 32 with all-fiberglass composites. The boat is scheduled to be launched in time for a debut at the 2004 Fort Lauderdale International Boat Show, with 20 more to be built within the first year.

The interior features a compact cuddy for overnight or weekend fishing trips.
