

JARRETT BAY 64

Launched in late December, the new Jarrett Bay 64 is loaded with innovations including a sofa lift which no longer requires removal of cushions and panels to access rod storage underneath and engine room Sub-Zero freezer drawers for out of the way, yet easily accessed functionality. Stepping through the saloon door you'll find the aforementioned L-shaped sofa to port and an additional sofa to starboard. The galley to port offers solid countertops and there's drawer cold and freezer storage below plus a convection microwave, sink, coffeemaker and cooktop and a liquor/wine storage cabinet. The dinette to starboard seats four comfortably and there's additional stool seating for two at the galley counter. An entertainment center with flat screen TV forward behind the dinette completes the salon. The three stateroom configuration features a three-bunk forward stateroom with two bunks over and one under plus drawer storage to port. The master stateroom offers a Queen-sized island berth plus lots of cabinet storage space. Upper and lower bunks plus drawer and cabinet storage highlight the crew's stateroom.

You'll find the same sense of open comfort on the fly-bridge with Jarrett Bay's trademark bench seating and built-in arm rest and cup holders. There's plenty of seating forward of the helm with storage below plus two barrel seats forward and an aft facing seat next to the helm.
