JARRETT BAY 46

Jarrett Bay's first build with pod drives is the 46-foot PERSISTENCE built for NASCAR star Jeff Burton and features an interior helm station. This traditional wide open layout provides 360-degree visibility from inside the salon and also gives a roomier appearance inside. To port upon entering the salon is a flat screen TV and entertainment center across from an L-shaped lounge to starboard while a second L-shaped lounge to port of the lower helm offers additional seating. Rich dark veneers contrast the light-colored fabrics and headliner while direct and indirect lighting accent the salon. Space-saving pod drives provide room for a second stateroom with twin bunks under the salon. The galley-down layout features all the amenities for Burton and his family to enjoy extended stays afloat. The master stateroom is forward and has an island berth and private head with shower while a second head with shower is adjacent to the galley.

The mezzanine cockpit has tackle storage to starboard while a teak Release Marine Gimbaled Rocket Launcher was chosen in lieu of a full fighting chair and provides considerable space savings. Teak deck and covering boards together with Sea Vision under water lights are a nice finishing touch. The fly bridge has unique barrel seats forward of a roomy helm that has helm and companion seats and a teak Palm Beach pod. A lounge to port offers additional seating and storage. The Bausch American half tower has LED spreader lights, recessed teaser reels and molded running lights and LED tri-color dome lights.
